Bridge work requires closing westbound I-94 ramp to northbound M-10 (Lodge Freeway) in Detroit Monday

Fast facts:

- MDOT is replacing the Cass Avenue overpass above I-94 in Detroit.
- Ongoing work at the Cass Avenue overpass requires closing the westbound I-94 ramp to northbound M-10 (Lodge Freeway) Monday morning.
- During the ramp closure, traffic will be detoured to southbound I-75 to access northbound M-10.

DETROIT, Mich. - Weather permitting, Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) contract crews will close the [westbound I-94 ramp to northbound M-10](#) at 5 a.m. Monday, Feb. 20. The ramp closure is necessary to allow crews to safely build a new barrier wall for the ongoing replacement of the Cass Avenue overpass above I-94.

Ramp traffic will be detoured via southbound I-75 to northbound M-10. The ramp is expected to remain closed until late summer.

The new Cass Avenue overpass will replace the original structure built in 1955. All work on this \$12.5 million investment is scheduled to be completed in early 2024.
