**Project information:**

This work is part of the advanced bridges portion of the [I-94 modernization project](#) in Detroit. The project team will be discussing the removal of the Beaubien Street, McClellan Avenue, and Seminole Street bridges over I-94. McClellan Avenue will be removed due to its proximity to the upcoming improvements at the I-94/M-3 (Gratiot Avenue) interchange. The Seminole and Beaubien streets overpasses are currently closed due to their poor condition. The Seminole Street bridge will be replaced in the future by a multi-modal structure one-block east at Iroquois Street. Beaubien Street will be replaced in the future at its current location.
